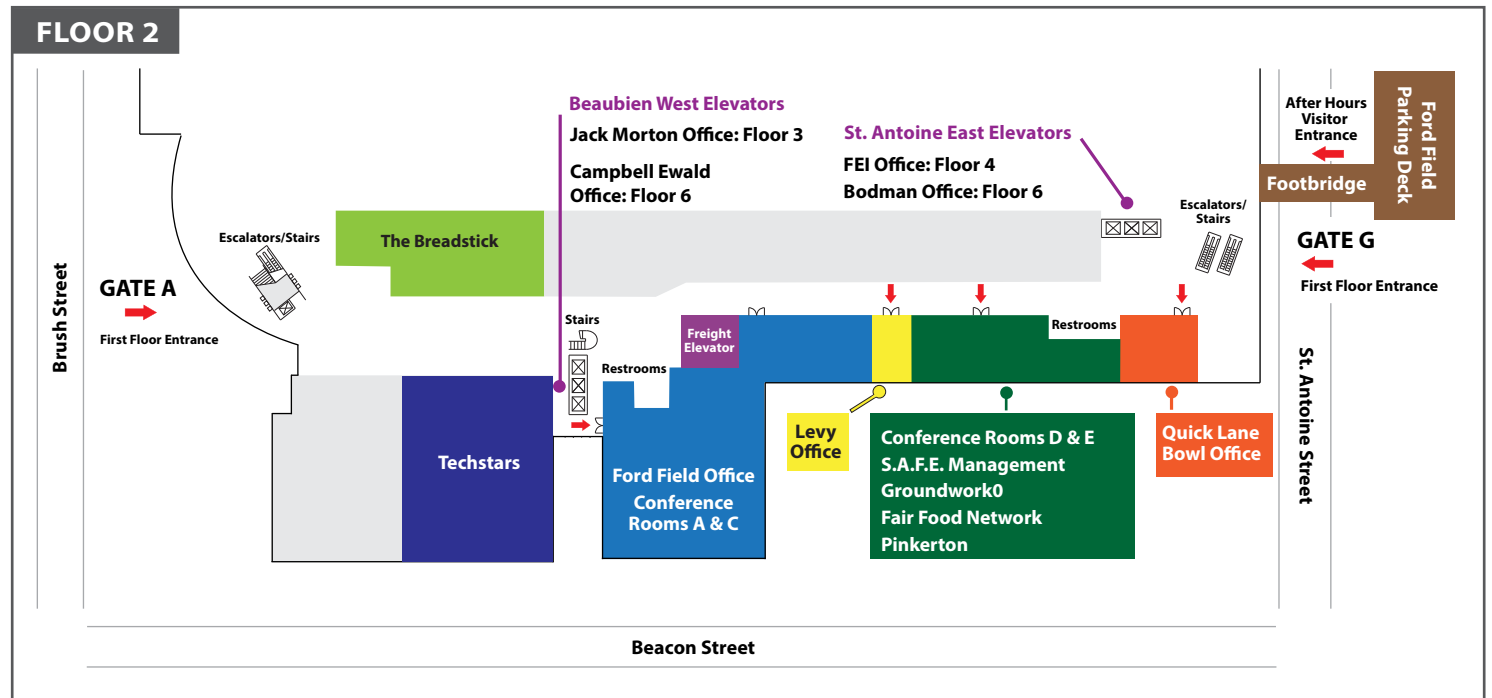
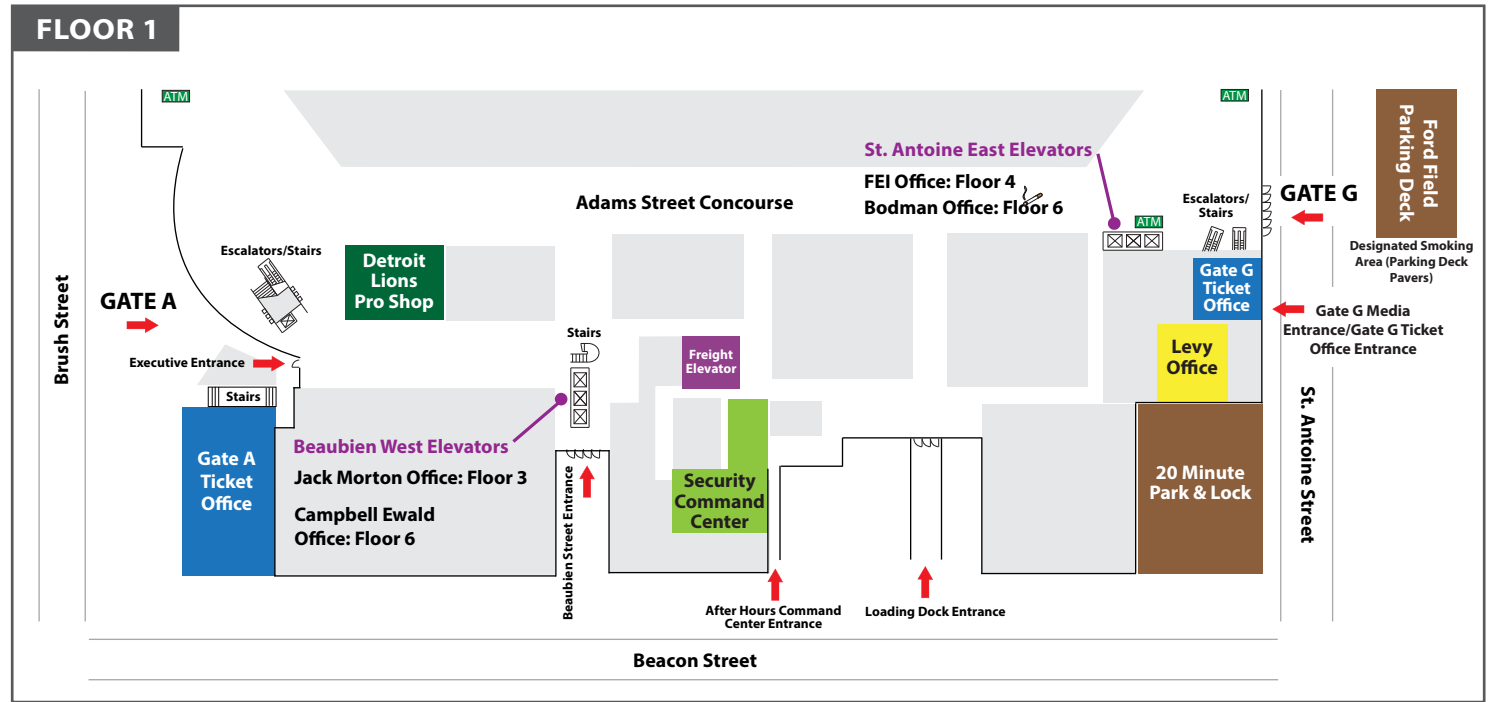

- Ford Field is one part stadium and one part warehouse. The Warehouse portion of Ford Field is actually the redesigned Hudson's Warehouse from the 1920's.
